Both downers, Lawrence Ractliffe and the Miserden Estate, to be contacted for rmission to carry out footpath restoration works.
Footpath which runs down Warnford house to Sudgrove house, on into geworth deviates significantly. It is believed that a land owner moved the otpath themselves and applied to have it confirmed. OW office says it's fine, but as it reaches a six-foot wide stream it is oblematic and needs to be corrected. was noted that GPS shows the old path.
